## Meeting Notes:

- Following introductions and a brief review of the committee purposes, the committee reviewed needs assessment and research results and recommendations received to date. We also reviewed the status of 4-H leadership resources currently available on the 4-H Teen Leadership webpage on [www.ohio4h.org](http://www.ohio4h.org).
- Joy Sharp agreed to chair the committee, and Greg Homan will serve as reporter and help facilitate the resource review process.
- We agreed upon the following committee goals, action strategies, and time lines:
  - ◆ The immediate goal of the committee is to develop, review and post lesson plans for effective team building activities for use by professionals, volunteers, and teen leaders in their youth leadership development programs.
    - ▶ At least five committee-reviewed team building activities will be posted on the 4-H Teen Leadership webpage at [www.ohio4h.org](http://www.ohio4h.org) by the end of May, 2005.
    - ▶ Lesson plans for at least 15 to 20 team building activities will be posted by late September, 2005.
      - Joy Sharp will invite other members of the Teen Leadership Priority Team to submit team building resources to be shared on the website, at next Monday's committee meetings.
      - Kathy Cox will include an invitation to bring resources to be posted, in the meeting reminder to be sent this afternoon.
  - ◆ Joy Sharp will follow up with committee members to confirm conference call dates and times in May. The purposes of the conference call(s) will be:
    - ▶ to identify at least five team building activities to be posted by the end of May,
    - ▶ to identify other team building leadership resources for which links should be provided on the website, and
    - ▶ to plan strategies for securing at least 10 additional team building activity lesson plans to be posted by late September.
  - ◆ It is the understanding of committee members that other Priority Teams and Teen Leadership Team Committees will be developing and posting many different leadership resources related to committee leadership, club officer leadership, camp counselor leadership, communications & public speaking, and other leadership development resource needs which emerged as high priorities in the youth leadership zoomerang results. The committee will support and promote these efforts. At our September meeting we will review what has been accomplished, discuss any remaining unmet needs, and identify next steps and strategies for securing other youth leadership development resources which may still be needed.
  - ◆ The next in-person committee meeting will be as part of the All 4-H Priority Teams Meeting on September 27, 2005.
