Committee goals, accomplishments, and tasks to be completed include (but are not limited to):

1. Expand and promote Ohio 4-H involvement in “Make A Difference Day” service projects.
 - Requested committee recommendations were shared with Jeff King related to grants provided by the Richard Stahl Family Endowment to support 4-H “Make A Difference Day” projects.
 - Joe Campbell was nominated by the committee to continue serving as the 2005 4-H Representative to the Ohio Make A Difference Committee. Nadine Fogt was nominated as a second representative, if 4-H is permitted to send two representatives, or if not, to represent Joe at any meetings he cannot attend.
 - A 4-H Service Leadership interactive display will be included in the 2005 Ohio State Fair 4-H Exhibits to promote the opportunities and to share information with potential 4-H participants.
 - The committee also discussed the merits of identifying and promoting a central theme for all Ohio 4-H “Make A Difference Day” service projects. Committee members will further explore various alternatives, and will develop a recommendation during the next conference call.
2. Complete the review process of the 4-H Community Service Officer resource materials developed by Nadine Fogt, and provide them on-line with other new 4-H officer materials.
3. Provide a 4-H Community Service project on the web.
 - Nadine will make contacts about the current status of the development of a new national 4-H community service project which was reported at the 2004 NAE4-HA Conference, and will send an update to other committee members.
4. Explore ways to assist 4-H’ers in maintaining records of their service leadership accomplishments.
