5.14.08 — Your keen sense of observation is key today. You'll learn how to investigate a crime scene and collect evidence. A visit to the lab will help you pinpoint the DNA of the culprit. At the crime scene you will look for clues, lift fingerprints and photograph the site. After dinner, process the crime data with your team and narrow the list of suspects. The evening ends with a mystery movie where everyone is guilty until proven innocent!

5.15.08 — Today you'll solve the case of the missing mascot! The morning begins with Dr. Bob Horton and a science discovery session. Then, you'll finish your project and present the evidence for parents and friends. All super sleuth participants will be recognized for their ingenious detective work. Case closed!

Camper's will be supervised by adult staff and collegiate 4-H counselors. Sessions will be taught by Ohio 4-H educators and volunteers from Battelle and Metro High School.
