

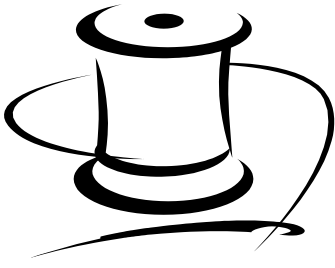
**Lunch time presentation by the 4-H State Fashion Board
