- \* learn a new way of life by living it during a 4-week homestay program.
- \* become part of a Norwegian family and learn more about themselves and Norway in the process.
- \* face the challenge of representing 4-H, Ohio and the United States.
- \* share their experiences with Ohioans upon their return.

## **BRIEF DESCRIPTION:**

Ohio youth will join 15 youth from around the country in the 4-H Norway Exchange. The State 4-H Office provides all support for the program, including orientation, travel arrangements, etc. The youth are welcomed into the home of a Norwegian host family, where they learn about the Norwegian culture on an everyday basis. Upon their return, they are encouraged to share their experiences with other Ohioans.
