Check in with the program coordinator 30 minutes before the program begins for specific directions, orientation and required setup. 2. Greet and welcome participants and their families as they arrive. Show them to the registration area and help them get registered at the time indicated for their class. Show them where they can store things before and after their class. Point out where the drinking fountains and restrooms are located. Help them relax and enjoy their participation in the program. This may include making announcements on the P.A. system. 3. Assist by organizing registration cards, distributing participation awards, introducing participants, picture taking and other responsibilities as needed. 4. When a class is over, help participants clear the exhibit area and store anything they need to store. Thank them for coming and congratulate them for being selected to represent their county at the Ohio State Fair. Make suggestions for other things for them to see and enjoy at the fair, and otherwise make sure when they leave that they are glad they came. 5. At the conclusion of the program, assist with clean-up and share ideas for "making the best better" before departing. 6.
