

4-H EVENT/OPPORTUNITY:

2010-11 State 4-H Fashion Board

DATE / DEADLINE:

Completed nominations are due to the State 4-H Office by February 1, 2010, or by the deadline for State 4-H Achievement Awards and Scholarships, whichever is later. County deadlines vary, but are typically in early January.

PROGRAM DESCRIPTION:

The State 4-H Fashion Board is the small group of outstanding 4-H teen clothing members selected from across the state to a) assist in conducting the State Fair 4-H Fashion Revue, 4-H clothing workshop sessions, and other events planned by the 4-H clothing committee, and to b) promote Ohio 4-H clothing projects and programs. Each county is invited to nominate one 2010-11 4-H Fashion Board nominee. Approximately 20 State 4-H Fashion Board members will be selected for one-year terms through an individual and group interview process during Ohio 4-H Teen Conference on Saturday, February 20.

The State 4-H Fashion Board meets in-person four times during the year, with conference calls and committee meetings being scheduled in-between if needed:

- an orientation meeting in mid-June to identify a theme, make plans, and divide assignments for the State Fair 4-H Fashion Revue.
- a July meeting to finalize plans, rehearse, and put together materials just prior to the State Fair 4-H Fashion Revue.
- for four days at the State Fair to carry out their assignments associated with the State 4-H Fashion Revue
- a fall meeting to evaluate and recognize their State 4-H Fashion Revue performance, and to plan their participation in the upcoming spring Ohio 4-H Teen Conference and Ohio 4-H Volunteer Conference workshop sessions.

State 4-H Fashion Board members must be present full-time to assist with the 2010 State 4-H Fashion Revue from 1 PM Monday, August 2 through 6:30 PM Thursday, August 5, and must make arrangements to be excused from all other schedule conflicts those four days. 4-H'ers who cannot make this commitment should not be nominated.

In addition, Fashion Board members are expected to be at the other three meetings (and attend Teen Conference and Volunteer Conference), or make arrangements with the Fashion Board Advisors for an excused absence if they cannot attend all the meetings.

Nomination Process:

Any 4-H member who has - a) completed a 4-H clothing project in 2009 and b) represented their county at the 2009 State Fair 4-H Fashion Revue or served on their 2009 County 4-H Fashion Board or County 4-H Fashion Revue Committee - is eligible to be nominated as their county's one nominee for the 2010-11 State 4-H Fashion Board. There are no age requirements, but the nominee needs to have enough successful 4-H clothing experience and leadership experience to be able to handle the responsibilities of being a State 4-H Fashion Board member, facilitating class circles and modeling practice at the State 4-H Fashion Revue, and leading sessions at Teen Conference and Volunteer Conference.

Selections will be made through reviews of application materials and interviews. Selection will be based on the nominees' potential for success in completing the roles and responsibilities outlined above, as evidenced by:

- experience and accomplishments in 4-H clothing projects
- past leadership and service related to clothing
- the application/nomination materials,
- how well the individual portrays the "seven clues to a total look" in their state fair 4-H outfit, in the outfit selected for the Teen Conference interviews and in other settings in which they may be observed, and
- performance in the selections interviews.

4-H clothing members who meet the eligibility requirements and are interested in being nominated for the 2010-11 State 4-H Fashion Board should contact their county OSU Extension Office for information about their county's nomination process. The nomination / application form to be completed by the one individual selected as their county's nominee is on the next page.

- Complete the information requested at the bottom of this page. It is okay to use the back of this page or to attach an extra page if you need more room to list all of your clothing projects or highlights. But please limit your list to no more than what you can fit onto this page and 1 additional page.
- Attach a short essay on this topic: *"Introducing _____ (your name) _____, a Candidate for the State 4-H Fashion Board!"* Essays should be no more than one page in length, with at least 1" margins on all sides, and no less than 12 point font type (not less than 15 letters per inch). Text from the essays of candidates selected for the 2010-11 Fashion Board may be posted on a Fashion Board section of the ohio4h.org website. The essay should include a brief overview of your 4-H clothing background and experiences, highlight service or leadership you may have provided related to clothing, explain why you want to be an State 4-H Fashion Board Member, and otherwise let the reader know why you are a good candidate for the State 4-H Fashion Board.
- Attach a letter of recommendation from a County Extension Educator, Extension Master Clothing Educator, your County 4-H Fashion Revue Coordinator, or another unrelated adult who can speak to why you are a good candidate to represent your county's 4-H clothing program as a State 4-H Fashion Board member.
- Attach two full-length photos of yourself
 - one in the outfit in which you competed at last year's State 4-H Fashion Revue (or if you did not compete in the 2009 State 4-H Fashion Revue, then attach a photo of yourself wearing another outfit that you made), and
 - a second photo of you in a different outfit that shows you know how to put together a "total look"
