Costa Rica 2010

with Ohio 4-H!

- Who:** 4-H youth ages 15-18 (must turn 15 by the date of travel)
- What:** Travel to Costa Rica with 4-H youth from across the U.S. An adult chaperone will travel with the group on international air routes and while in Costa Rica. Live with a Costa Rican host family during your stay. Experience the Rain Forest and 4-S Camp!
- When:** **June 19 – July 17, 2010**
- Where:** Departure Orientation in Houston prior to flight to San Jose, Costa Rica where there will be an Arrival Orientation to introduce you to the country and culture.
- How:** This exchange is coordinated with the Fundacion Nacional de Clubes 4-S who will organize the Arrival Orientation and the host family stays.
- Cost:** Approximately \$2,650 (depends upon airfare). Price Includes:
- Administrative Support from Ohio 4-H, Costa Rica 4-S and the "States' 4-H International Programs" office from start to finish
 - Round-Trip Airfare
 - Pre-trip conference calls
 - Orientations in Dallas & San Jose
 - Medical Insurance
 - In-Costa Rica expenses: transportation, lodging, meals
 - Field trip to the Rain Forest
 - 3 nights 4 days at a 4-S camp (with 250 Costa Rican youth)
 - Adult Chaperone Accompaniment beginning in U.S. Gateway City

Scholarships **\$600 and up will be awarded to all youth selected for this program**
Application Deadline: **January 19**
Required Selection Interviews: **January 23 – 24 in Columbus** (one parent must accompany applicant)

Payment schedule: (Fuel Surcharge & Air Taxes are estimated. Will be adjusted when ticketed on 3/1.)

- January 19 - Application with \$850 deposit + \$50 application fee (contact us for payee info)
- March 1 - Airfare
- May 1 - Remaining Balance

Cancellation Policy: (Cancellations must be made in writing)

- Airfare is non-refundable once issued.
- All other payments are non-refundable after each payment deadline, except for \$500 of the January 19 deposit, which is refundable until April 1.
- For exceptional circumstances, refunds are made on a case-by-case basis
