NORWAY 2010

with Ohio 4-H!

- Who:** 4-H youth ages 16-19 (must turn 16 by the date of travel)
- What:** Travel to Norway with 4-H youth from across the U.S. (an adult chaperone will also travel with the group). Live with a Norwegian host family during your stay. The 4-week program will include 1 week at Nordic Camp where participants will camp out in tents and sleeping bags with 1,000 Norwegian 4H-ers at a site near the city of Hamar.
- When:** June 30 – August 2, 2010
- Where:** Departure Orientation in Chicago prior to flight to Oslo where there will be an Arrival Orientation to introduce you to Norway.
- How:** This exchange is coordinated with the 4-H Norge who will organize the Arrival Orientation and the host family stays.
- Cost:** Approximately \$4,150 (depends upon airfare). Price Includes:
- Administrative Support from Ohio 4-H, 4-H Norge, and the “States’ 4-H International Programs” office from start to finish
 - Round-Trip Airfare
 - Pre-trip conference calls
 - Orientations in Chicago & Oslo
 - Medical Insurance
 - In-Norway expenses: transportation, lodging, meals,
 - 1-week at Nordic Camp
 - Adult Chaperone Accompaniment beginning in U.S. Gateway City

Scholarships **\$600 and up will be awarded to all youth selected for this program**
Application Deadline: **January 19**
Required Selection Interviews: **January 23 – 24 in Columbus** (one parent must accompany applicant)

Payment schedule: (Fuel Surcharge & Air Taxes are estimated. Will be adjusted when ticketed on 3/1.)

- January 19 - Application with \$850 deposit + \$50 application fee (contact us for payee info)
- March 1 - Airfare
- May 1 - Remaining Balance

Cancellation Policy: (Cancellations must be made in writing)

- Airfare is non-refundable once issued.
- All other payments are non-refundable after each payment deadline, except for \$500 of the January 19 deposit, which is refundable until April 1.
- For exceptional circumstances, refunds are made on a case-by-case basis
